I worked there for 6 months as the Lead Recovery Coach until they closed down due to the Covid-19 pandemic. I began working for The Hornbuckle Foundation in March of 2022 as a Recovery Coach. I completed all my CCAR classes and began working on getting my NCPRSS. I love being able to work in Recovery and be able to give to other addicts something I never had when I was in my early Recovery.
